- **Small Group Scenarios** — The scenarios help students apply information from all aspects of the GEMS course

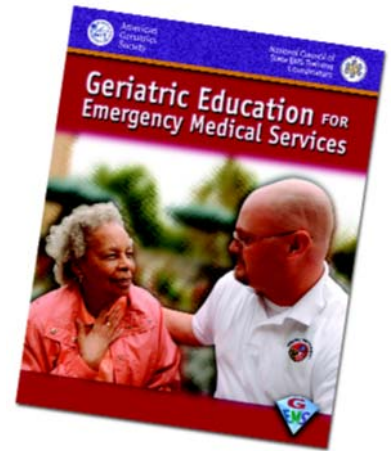
